- 2. Jumping classes will be limited to the first 30 entries.
- 3. In all cases the Judge's decision will be final.
- 4. The right is reserved to alter or cancel classes or reduce prize money according to the number of entries.
- 5. The organisers do not accept liability for accidents or injuries to horses or riders, or damage or loss to vehicles or property anywhere on the showground.
- 6. Correct headgear (PAS015/BS.EN1384) and dress must be worn at all times when riding.
- 7. Objections may be made to the Secretary in writing accompanied by £20.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 8. We ask all vehicles to park neatly and not to "muck-out" on the car park area.
- 9. All jumping classes will be judged equivalent to BSJA rules, unless stated to the contrary.
- 10. Age taken from 1st January 2018.
- 11. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- 12. It is the responsibility of the handler, rider and groom to ensure that they are capable of being in full control of their animal whilst on the showground.
